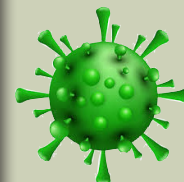

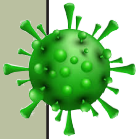

Digital entries only please.

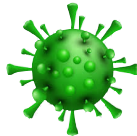
